Dear 4-H Clubs, Volunteers, and Members:

All 4-H Clubs from Grand Traverse, Leelanau, Benzie, Antrim and Kalkaska are welcome to create and exhibit a club booth display. Club booth displays should present the theme "Oh, The Places You'll Go with 4-H!". Create an educational display, tell a story about your 4-H club members, show community service and project areas your club has participated in, etc. It is okay to use pictures and content from previous years! Booths will be awarded certificates such as most creative, best organized, and the top three winners will win VISA gift cards (1st=\$100; 2nd=\$75, 3rd=\$50), large ribbons, and a certificate. To reserve a club booth space, sign up on the form and be prepared to set up your booth Thursday or Friday, August 1st and 2nd, anytime from 12-9:00 pm, or Saturday, August 3rd, from 9:00 am-1:00 pm in the Tanner Building. All independent projects and club booth displays must be complete by 1:00 pm on the 3rd.

**Cloverbud Activities:** Cloverbud activities will be held again this year in the Tanner Building Monday-Friday from 10-11 am and again from 2-4 pm. Join 4-H youth leaders and volunteers with youth ages 5-7 to make and take crafts. Our Cloverbud Games will be under the DA Tent on Saturday the 10th at 4:00 pm! ### Awards and Demonstrations

#### BEST 4-H CLUB DISPLAY



Judging criteria: Member participation, originality, creativity, use of 4-H Exhibit Building theme, appropriate club sign. A Best Club Display banner will be placed in the 1st Place club's display area by Saturday the 3rd. At the 4-H Awards ceremony on Saturday the 10th, the top three winners of the Best Club Display will be presented with a large ribbon and a VISA gift card for their club (1st=\$100; 2nd=\$75, and 3rd=\$50). All booths will be awarded certificates such as most creative, best organized, etc.

#### **4-H INDEPENDENT PROJECT EXHIBITOR RULES**

We are **not** offering judging on 4-H Independent Projects this year in the 4-H Tanner Building. Youth may place their projects in their club's booth display for the chance to win the top three club booth display prizes, or they may take exhibit their projects in the Fair's Evelyn Heim Building. Please see the Fair Premium Book and complete the **online** registration form to enter projects in the Evelyn Heim Building for the chance to win ribbons and premiums. #### 4-H INTERVIEW and DEMONSTRATIONS PROCESS

4-H Interviews are available for any 4-H members interested, including cloverbuds. 4-H Exhibit interviews will be held on Monday from 11 am – 3 pm in the Tanner Building.

Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded for interviews in the following age groups: 8-11, 12-15, 16-19. Cloverbuds (ages 5-7) are encouraged to participate in the interviews, and will receive participation ribbons. Demonstrations must be no longer than 15 minutes in length. Youth may bring a club display as part of their interview or demonstration.

**4-H CLOVER AWARD INTERVIEWS** Fill out and submit a <u>Clover Award Application</u> (for youth ages 10-19) by Wednesday, July 31st, 2024. You may send these to Rosali (collierr@msu.edu). The top three finalists will be contacted to be interviewed on Monday, August 5th in the Tanner Building.
